- **The Mass** has had different names over the years. In the New Testament the most common name is the breaking of the bread. It has also been called the “Lord’s Supper”, “Sacred Mystery”, “Holy Communion”, “memorial of the Lord’s passion and death”, “Holy Sacrifice” and the “Eucharist”. All these names capture an important insight into a particular aspect of the Mass. The word “Eucharist” means “thanksgiving” and it expresses the spirit that characterises the Christian community as it celebrates this great gift. The word Mass comes from the Latin form of the final dismissal at the end of the celebration. The congregation is told “Ite, missa est – go you are sent forth”. The term “Mass”, then underlines the fact that the Christian community is sent into the world to witness to the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- **Tax Relief for Donations to Dunhill and Fenor Parish.** In early September, we posted the Tax Reclaim Form to those Donors who exceeded the threshold of €250 during 2013 Tax Year. We need to once again remind those donors who have yet to sign and return the Tax Reclaim Form to us, to please help us with this.
