Tea and coffee will be provided in the monastery after the prayer. All are welcome to this evening of quiet prayer and reflection.
- Next Sunday, 3 October, is **Day for Life 2010**, a day dedicated to raising awareness about the meaning and value of human life at every stage and in every condition. A special feature is available on www.catholicbishops.ie to highlight the theme of this year's Day for Life which is the meaning of Christian death and care for those who are dying. The feature includes the text of the Pastoral Letter, published by the Irish Bishops' to mark Day for Life, as well as a selection of video resources, background to Day for Life, and other useful links.
