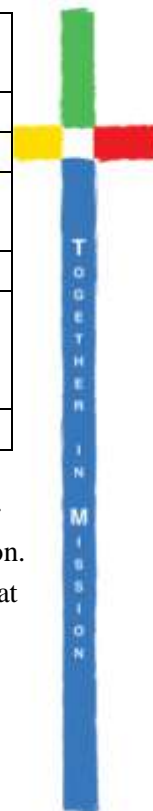

- There will be **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** in Dunhill Church this coming Wednesday from after 10.00 a.m. Mass until 1.00 p.m. and in Fenor Church on Friday from after 10.00 a.m. Mass until 12.00 noon.
- The **Annual Collection for the Propagation of the Faith** (Mission Sunday Collection) is being taken up at all Masses this weekend. - The **Dunhill & Fenor Parish Pastoral Council** (PPC) is currently distributing nomination forms for new members of the council. A parish meeting will be held on **Tuesday, 02nd November, in the Dunhill Education Centre at 8.00 p.m.** At this meeting the purpose of the PPC and the role of its members will be explained. - The next Mass of the **Do this in Memory programme** will be celebrated next Saturday evening (October 30th) at 6.30 p.m. in Fenor Church. All the boys and girls who are preparing for first Holy Communion will bring their rosary beads to that Mass, where they will be blessed for use during prayer time at home. If you would like to have devotional items blessed please bring them too.

- **Fenor Church Choir** will resume choir rehearsals this Wednesday evening at 7.30 p.m. in Fenor Church. New members are always welcome and may just turn up on the night.
- You are cordially to attend a **Taizé Prayer Service** in the Blessed Edmund Rice Chapel, Mount Sion, on Friday, November 05th at 8.00 p.m. Music will be provided by the Waterford Peace Choir and tea and coffee will be served in the monastery after the prayer. All are welcome to this time of quiet prayer and reflection.
- It is now three months since devastating **floods hit Pakistan**. Over that time people have generously donated over €5.5million to help survivors of the disaster, €2.5million of which was raised in the church collections in August. Thanks to the generosity of clergy and parishioners Trócaire was able to rescue over 20,000 people from the floodwaters in the first weeks of the disaster and provide more than 100,000 people with food, water, hygiene kits and other essentials. Trócaire is now providing seeds, tools and other essentials so that families can begin to recover and rebuild their livelihoods.
