- Tuesday is the Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed, or **All Souls Day**. Masses will be celebrated in both churches at 10.00 a.m. The **Holy Souls Novena** will begin in Dunhill Church on that day and will continue for nine days. The Holy Souls Novena will begin in Fenor Church on Monday, November 15<sup>th</sup>.
- The **Dunhill & Fenor Parish Pastoral Council** (PPC) is hosting a parish meeting this Tuesday, November 02<sup>nd</sup>, in the Dunhill Education Centre at 8.00 p.m. During the meeting the purpose of the PPC and the role of its members will be explained. In any case, everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend the meeting.

- An **Evening of Remembrance** will be held at St. John's Pastoral Centre, Waterford, on Wednesday, November 03<sup>rd</sup>, from 7.30 p.m. until 9.00 p.m. The evening, which will be facilitated by Ann O'Farrell, will provide a sacred space to honour family, friends, and all who have died, and will include Scripture reading, personal prayer time, silence, music and a celebration of light.
- Friday is the **First Friday** of November and Fr Paul will be visiting the sick and housebound with the Sacraments. If you, or anyone you know, would like to celebrate Confession, Anointing of the Sick or to receive the Eucharist please let us know as soon as possible.
- You are cordially to attend a **Taizé Prayer Service** in the Blessed Edmund Rice Chapel, Mount Sion, on Friday, November 05<sup>th</sup> at 8.00 p.m. Music will be provided by the Waterford Peace Choir and tea and coffee will be served in the monastery after the prayer. All are welcome to this time of quiet prayer and reflection.
