Also highlighted are some of details on the Opening Ceremony and the Statio Orbis (Final Mass), including how to get to the venues, and new information is being posted every day. Almost 2,000 volunteers have received their training and are ready to meet you as you arrive. They are there to help so please let them know if you need assistance.
- A gathering of **International Eucharistic Congress pilgrims** from Dunhill & Fenor and Tramore & Carbally will take place at the Holy Cross Church, Tramore, this Wednesday, 06th June, at 7.30 p.m. While all are welcome, it will be geared towards those who are attending the Congress in June and will look at specifics of transport, etc.
- The fourth National Collection for the **50th International Eucharistic Congress** will take place next weekend and there is a yellow envelope provided in your box at home for this collection. - Next weekend marks the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord and to mark the occasion there will be a **Corpus Christi Procession** in Tramore on Saturday evening, June 09th. The procession will begin in Holy Cross Church after 7.30 p.m. Mass before processing through Peter Street and Moonlaun, into Sweetbriar Lawn for prayers, before continuing to the Marian Shrine in Marian Terrace for Benediction. Children who received their First Holy Communion or Confirmation recently will be especially welcome. If the weather is bad, there will be a shorter procession in and around the church. Parishioners of Dunhill & Fenor are especially encouraged to attend.
- The Parish Pastoral Councils of Tramore and Carbally have announced that the **Times of Sunday Masses** will be changing from this coming weekend (02nd & 03rd June).
