- Fr Paul and the Parish Pastoral Council will host a **Gathering of All Parish Volunteers** on Sunday, 14th October, at the Seaview Celtic Clubhouse, Annestown, from 3.00 p.m. until 6.00 p.m. This is an opportunity to say thanks to all the adults who help out in any way and make a positive contribution to the life of the parish. Monsignor Michael Olden will speak on the history of Christianity in the area and supper will be served afterwards. Please ensure that you have completed and returned your volunteering paperwork (Yellow Volunteering Application Form, Green Volunteering Declaration Form and White Garda Vetting Form) to the office prior to that day.
- Thanks to all the children of the parish who serve the community as **Altar Servers and Choir Members** and to those who have volunteered for training for these important ministries. Altar Server training will take place in both churches for the next few Saturdays and new young voices have already been heard in Dunhill Choir. Our parish is compliant with the Child Safeguarding Policies of the Diocese of Waterford & Lismore, available on our website.
- A new **Church Organ has been installed in Fenor Church** to replace an instrument which has given much trouble over the past few years. Thanks to a major donation of €3,700 from the Fenor Barn Dance Committee we have been able to purchase this Viscount Vivace 30 organ. We are very grateful to the Committee and to those who supported the Barn Dance and we look forward to singing many songs of praise in the coming years.
- To commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the Opening of the Second Ecumenical Council at the Vatican a talk will be given by Sandra Cullen on the topic: **‘A Teaching Church: our role in handing on faith’** this Monday evening, 01st October, from 7.00 to 9.00 p.m. in St Patrick’s Parish Centre, Loughboy, Kilkenny. All are welcome.
- This is the time of year when the **Parish Pastoral Council** (PPC) seeks new members for the council. A PPC is essentially a visionary body that plans for the future needs of the parish. Rather than simply dealing with issues as they arise, the PPC looks ahead and creates the structures needed for a well run parish, encourages parishioners to participate, and provides them with any training or that they might require. The PPC is a consultative body – its purpose is not to run the parish but to assist and advise the priest in his pastoral duties. A meeting to discuss the purpose of the PPC and the role of its members will be held on Tuesday, 16th October, in the Dunhill Education Centre at 8.00 p.m. Every parishioner is invited to nominate one or more persons, including themselves, for council membership, but please get their agreement before nominating them. In any case, everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend the meeting. Nomination forms are available in both churches.
- A meeting about this year’s **Fenor Sale of Work** will take place in the Parochial House, Fenor, this Tuesday, 02nd October, at 7.30 p.m. All are welcome.
