The Mission collection is organised by the Society for the Propagation of the Faith and it is collected by every Church around the world, including the poorest. Mission Sunday provides Catholics with the opportunity to recommit themselves to the Church's missionary activity, through prayer, sacrifice and financial contribution. Funds raised are used to assist missionaries to help communities spiritually and materially. Contributions are also used to build simple mission churches, to educate seminarians and to assist in the formation of catechists and lay leaders. It is also used for the building of health clinics for children, emergency aid in times of war or natural disaster and to care for refugees. The theme for World Mission Sunday in Ireland this year is 'Growing in Communion' so today we celebrate the work of our 1,700 missionaries and all missionaries throughout the world.
