- An **Evening of Remembrance** will be held in St. John's Pastoral Centre, Waterford, on Thursday, 15th November, from 7.30 to 9.00 p.m. The evening will provide a sacred space to honour family, friends and all who have died. We invite you to a time of prayerful reflection during this special month. This evening will include Scripture Reading, Personal Prayer, Silence, Music and a Celebration of Light. All are welcome.
- Internationally renowned composer **Fr Liam Lawton** will present a workshop at St John's Pastoral Centre this Tuesday, November 6th, at 7.30 p.m. Fr Liam is will be teaching his new Mass in the Irish language – 'Aifreann Muire na nGael'. - The **50th International Eucharistic Congress Special Commemorative DVD** has been launched. The Congress was attended by approximately 150,000, with several thousand pilgrims coming from outside Ireland, representing more than 114 countries. The DVD includes footage of the Opening Ceremony and Mass in the RDS, the 'Statio Orbis' closing ceremony and Mass in Croke Park as well as a 'Would You Believe' television special. The all-regions DVD has more than 400 minutes of footage and is available from many retail outlets.
- Many of our altar servers joined with servers from other parishes this weekend to participate in an **Altar Servers' Retreat** at St John's Pastoral Centre. We take this opportunity to thank them for their very important ministry in our community and are particularly grateful to those who train them for their ministry.
