- A **Trócaire collection** will be take place at all Masses next Saturday and Sunday, 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> November, to support the people of Syria where over 100,000 people have lost their lives after two years of war and over 8.4 million people (approximately half of whom are children) are in need of humanitarian assistance. This crisis is unfolding in an area of great historical and religious significance for Christians worldwide. The situation faced by the people of Syria is a critical one with the country facing the worst humanitarian crisis in a generation. Trócaire is working in partnership with local church agencies in Syria and along neighbouring borders to support survivors. Since 2011, vital emergency aid has reached over 273,000 people. Your support will help to get food, water, clothing, shelter, medical and psycho-social supports to those most in need. The collection will be taken at the door as people leave and should be seen only as an opportunity for people to contribute to the work of Trócaire.
- The **Diocesan Pastoral Council** has provided an opportunity for all parishioners throughout the diocese to actively participate in a review of the Diocesan Pastoral Plan “Building in Faith” and to contribute to the future development of pastoral needs for the diocese, by completing a survey/questionnaire. Your participation in the survey has been greatly appreciated.
- Sr Antoinette Dilworth will present evenings of reflection as we prepare to close the **Year of Faith**. Entitled ‘Moving beyond the Year of Faith and setting out on the journey with new eyes and new hearts’, the reflections will be presented on Monday, 18<sup>th</sup> November, at the Park Hotel in Dungarvan, and again on Wednesday, 20<sup>th</sup> November, at St John’s Pastoral Centre in Waterford. All are welcome to attend so mark it in your diary.
- **Fenor Sale of Work** will take place on Sunday week, November 24<sup>th</sup>, in Fenor National School. Donations of cakes and other items for the spinner will be gratefully received as well as books and unwanted items for the bric-a-brac stall. Items can be left into Fenor School anytime during this week or given to any committee member.
