- <u>The Advent Wreath</u> is made from evergreens, leaves and branches which remind us that God is unchanging, eternal. The round shape of the wreath reminds us that God is without beginning or end. The three purple candles and the pink one represent the four weeks of Advent. The purple candles represent penance and sorrow for sin. The pink candle (Third Sunday of Advent) represents the joy of living in God's presence. The white candle in the centre is lit on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day when Advent is over and we celebrate the Birth of Jesus, the true light who enlightens all people, a light that darkness cannot overpower.
