- **Tax Relief for Donations to Dunhill and Fenor Parish:** Last week we posted reminder letters to those Donors who exceeded the threshold of €250 during 2013 Tax Year but who did not return their forms. By returning this form it will enable us to reclaim tax which can then be used towards the running costs of our parish, including upcoming repair work to the roof on Fenor church. Most all parishes in the Diocese are using this tax reclaim system to help with the running costs in their Parishes. This scheme is completely confidential and will not affect your current tax situation in any way. A sincere thanks to everyone who contributes to the different Collections we have in place in our parish.  
In recent days we have posted **CHY 3 Certs for 2014** which requires your PPS number and signature. By completing the form you are allowing your parish to reclaim tax already paid by you, which will be used towards the day to day maintenance costs in your Parish.
- The annual **Mass at St. Declan's Holy Well**, Toor, Aglish will take place on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> July at 12 noon. This is an annual Mass in honour of St. Declan and will be celebrated on his feast day. All are welcome.
- The national **Pilgrimage to Croagh Patrick** on Ireland's holy mountain will take place on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July. Around 25,000 pilgrims climb this holy mountain, many in their bare feet. Pilgrims can avail of the Sacrament of Reconciliation on the summit from 7.30 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. Mass will be celebrated every half hour beginning at 8:00 a.m. with the final Mass commencing at 2.00 p.m.
