For over 200 years, Brothers and lay colleagues have continued that mission in the liberating education of the young. What began in Mount Sion continues today on all 6 continents. Please join them for any or all of the events which begin nightly at 8.00 p.m. All are welcome. Many Waterford people are not even aware that Blessed Edmund’s tomb is in the chapel at Mount Sion.
