- Next Friday, April 28th, the **Sacrament of Confirmation** will be celebrated with our young parishioners in Dunhill Church by Bishop Alphonsus. Confirmation day is a very special day in the life of the Parish. It is the day when our young people are accepted as adult members of our Christian Community. It is the day when the young people accept responsibility to be active members of their Faith – community. It is the day when endowed with the gift of the Holy Spirit they become evangelisers. It is the day when they deepen their friendship and relationship with Jesus. It is or should be the day when they are equipped with the tools to meet life and the many questions it will pose. It is the day when they become the enablers and support group of their peers.
