Pope Francis canonised Jacinta and Francisco during his visit to Fatima last Saturday. Jacinta and Francisco were beatified by Pope John Paul II on May 13th 2000. Jacinta and Francisco died during the flu epidemic that raged from 1918 to 1920. Lucia went away to school, aged 14 and entered the convent of the Sisters of Dorothy in 1928. She transferred to the Carmelites in 1947. She died on 15th February 2005 aged 97.
