The Prophets of the old Testament have a special place in the Liturgy of the Word during Advent. Their message was about hope. In difficult times they gave people hope that God would send a Saviour. In the parish of Reisk in the year of 1831 the population was 971. Ten years later the population was 1072. There were 160 houses in the parish. All of the people were Roman Catholics and a 'pay daily' school had on its register - 14 boys and 11 girls.
