**Tax Relief for Donations to Dunhill and Fenor Parish**

During the coming week we will be posting out the Tax Reclaim Form to those Donors who exceeded the threshold of €250 during the 2018 Tax Year. If you currently pay tax under the PAYE system or are self assessed and are in a position to help the parish at no further cost to yourself, signing and returning the form promptly would be greatly appreciated. Those of you who have contributed this amount during any or all of the last five years should expect a letter during the coming week explaining how we can reclaim money from the Revenue. This enduring cert will be valid for the next five years.

Example: Donations of €250 during a calendar year, will be worth €362. Donations of €350 will be worth €522 to the parish. This scheme does not affect your tax liability in any way. All donations are completely confidential. For more information contact the parish office 051-396892.
