The Traditional May Procession in our parish will take place today Sunday after 9.30 a.m. Mass in Dunhill. The Dunhill and Fenor First Communion children with their parents are also invited to join us in this procession to the Grotto where we will recite the Rosary together.

Tax Relief for Donations to Dunhill and Fenor Parish
 The Parish office have posted out the forms for the tax rebate for donations for the year 2018. A full explanation for the scheme is included. We have to close the date for return of these forms on Friday 21st June. If you currently pay tax under the PAYE system or are self assessed and are in a position to help the parish at no further cost to yourself, signing and returning the form promptly would be greatly appreciated. Those of you who have contributed this amount during any or all of the last five years will have received the letter explaining how we can reclaim money from the Revenue. This enduring cert will be valid for the next five years.
 Example:
 Donations of €250 during a calendar year, will be worth €362.
 Donations of €350 will be worth €522 to the parish.
 We can then submit our claim to Revenue. The Parish benefits greatly from this scheme. We once again thank everyone sincerely for your generous contributions.
