Hospital Chaplaincy

It is very regrettable that the HSE has failed to formally appoint a 2nd Chaplain in University Hospital Waterford, even though this position had already been established in Fr. Matthew's time. It means that there will be no Chaplaincy cover on Fridays and Saturdays. As a result, Mass will not be celebrated on those days, and there will be no support available for the terminally ill and the bereaved. This is very insensitive and uncaring on behalf of the HSE. If you feel strongly about this issue, you might consider contacting your local council/political representative(s).

East County Waterford Community Based Drugs Initiative (CBDI).

Are you concerned about your own or somebody else's Alcohol or Drug use? **How We Can Help:** Based in Tramore and offer a range of sensitive, nonjudgemental

and confidential services to members of the public in the Eastern half of County Waterford.

Individuals: The community drugs worker will collaborate with you to work out your future aims and goals regarding your drug or alcohol use.

The CBDI aims to inform you of relevant services in the local area including counselling, and refer you on if required. Help and support is also available to family members, parents and partners of those who have substance misuse issues.

Families: In order to meet local demand we facilitate Family Support Group meetings. This offers those affected, a safe space to meet with others in a similar situation with whom you can relate. You can also obtain knowledge and information on learning to cope with manipulation and learning how to mind YOU.

Community: We aim to empower communities and advocate on their behalf in response to drug related issues in their locality. The projects are open to developing new responses when the community brings something to our attention.
