### **GDPR - General Data Protection Rules**


As most of you are aware new Data Protection Rules have come into effect, and we at Dunhill & Fenor Parish along with everyone else must comply with these rules. There will be a number of changes to requests for Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage Certificates, coming into effect in the next few weeks and for general requests for information.

We would ask you to bear with us as we comply with these new rules and please understand that these changes are being made because they are now the law.

## Alpha - Coming Soon to Tramore!

Join us this autumn as we begin a new parish programme to explore our faith, to share testimonies and to experience fellowship as a community of believers in Jesus Christ. The Alpha programme has already been running very successfully in various local parishes throughout the diocese, including St. Paul's, St. Joseph & Benildus, and Dungarvan. It is an 11-week programme, and sessions are held once a week. Each session begins with the group sharing a meal together, followed by a short DVD presentation on a particular topic of faith, and afterwards there is time spent discussing the video in small groups. It is especially effective for those who are not regularly practicing their faith, and for those who are not church-goers. Alpha has proved to be a helpful tool throughout the world in bringing people back to their faith, and leading them to discover more deeply the person and presence of Jesus Christ in their lives.
