The course is designed to invite people to rethink their faith in Jesus Christ, and to get a conversation going among like-minded people on the importance of faith in our lives today. Each session begins with a shared meal, followed by a short DVD presentation on a particular topic of faith, and concludes with time for discussion in small groups. Places are limited, so book early.
