1st Sunday of Advent The season of Advent begins today Advent is one of the four special seasons in the Church's Year. The others are Christmastide, Lent and the Easter Season. The Church's Year begins with Advent. The word "Advent" means "arrival". It is a period of preparation for Christians when we celebrate the arrival of Christ. It recalls the period before the birth of Christ when the Jews waited for the coming of the Messiah. The Prophets of the old Testament have a special place in the Liturgy of the Word during Advent. Their message was about hope. In difficult times they gave people hope that God would send a Saviour. Their message for us is still one of hope, that God cares for us and that the future is with God.
