Tomorrow, Monday 10<sup>th</sup> February, The Majestic Hotel, Tramore at 10.00 am, 11.30 am & 1.00 pm

When someone collapses in front of you, in your home, or in your work...will you be ready? **The Irish Heart Foundation** will make sure you are. The course is suitable for the general public and are

appropriate for anyone who may not have any experience of performing CPR. They follow a video based, practice-while watching format and an instructor will be there to guide you and help you to learn how to perform high quality CPR. The course includes lots of time for you to practice on a manikin so by the end of the course you should be confident you'll know how to provide CPR in an emergency. We all rely on our friends and family, but could they rely on you if they suddenly collapsed? Now's your chance to make sure you are prepared to save a life. It could even be your life.
