Public Meeting Held in Feb 2012 to gauge interest. Mandate provided to renovate the existing Hall. Committee Formed and to date -Formulated our Constitution (operating under DFBA) **Opened Bank Account** Secured initial local funding (School / Gymkhana / Parish) Secured 25 year lease on the property from Diocese Engaged Architect / Quantity Surveyor **Opened Discussions with Waterford Leader** Put in place Finance Plan – with a team of Volunteers
